Job Title: Music Teacher

Job Purpose: Provide a nurturing Christian environment in which every child can grow and develop spiritually, intellectually, emotionally, socially and physically.

Responsibilities:

- Adhere to all teacher policies and to the state licensing requirements of the state of Texas including but not limited to completing 24 hours of teacher in-service training each year and CPR/First Aid training.
- Attend all required staff meetings as well as mandatory training in August. **Not attending these trainings results in the teacher locating and paying for replacement trainings.**
- Plan and implement age-appropriate lesson plans using the Musikgarten curriculum.
- Conduct music classes using voice, recorded music and instruments.
- Develop and maintain a constructive and ongoing rapport with children and parents.
- Organize and keep current all curriculum/handouts/instruments.
- YPS – Create and conduct a week of Parent Music Days in the Spring for parents to join with their children in a music class.
- OPS – Create and conduct a musical performance at least once a year.
- OPS – Join in Chapel services to lead music when needed.
- Provide musical materials for teachers to use in order to enhance their classrooms.
- Attend any required Musikgarten trainings (in person or online).
- Write a monthly blurb for the newsletter highlighting the musical lessons being taught.
- Perform any other assignments the Director deems necessary.

Qualifications:

- High School diploma
- Basic understanding of musical concepts (tempo, rhythm, pitch)
- Confidence to lead a class of children and teachers
- Has some knowledge of child development
- Display a vibrant pursuit and relationship with Jesus Christ
- Maintain a punctual and faithful attendance throughout the year
